District

This genealogy was assembled over several years. The original was paginated and indexed for names in 1971. Since then there have been three major supplements. Many new pages had to be inserted between the existing numbered pages. This necessitated using letters (74a is somewhat of a substitute for the original 74; 75.3 comes between 75 and 76.). Two indexes of the supplemental material were made. All three name indexes should be used to discover if a certain name appears in this genealogy.

A new arrangement puts NARRATIVES after FAMILY PAGES which is followed by the INDEX. NARRATIVES and INDEX are neither paginated nor indexed.

After NARRATIVES are some pages showing how our progenitors may be traced much farther back in legend and myths with many facts thrown in. We refer to the story of Cadwallader who was one of the links in the Eaton chain. More particularly we refer to the sequences which trace the ancestry of Lydia Ann Hall back to Adam.

Following the two page story of Cadwallader toward the end of NARRATIVES are four pages at the bottoms of which appear the names of "LYDIA ANN HALL, 1834-1926, m. DAVID WOOD KING, 1830-1921." Those pages trace the ancestry of Lydia (Hall) King by various routes back to David I, Richard, the Fearless and Henry I at the tops of the pages. On the next page, David I, Richard, and Henry I, at the bottom, are traced back to PRINCE COEL and MARCOMIR (at the top). The next two pages go on back to JACOB or ISRAEL and then on to Adam.

Nine generations up from Mr. and Mrs King appears, "Henry Scott, d. 1624, m. Martha Whatlock who came to America." If you turn to pp. 34, 139 or 139a in our PROGENITORS genealogy you will find that Henry Scott (2132) and Martha Whatlock (2133) are in our ancestry. We are descended from Henry and Martha (Whatlock) Scott (2132x2133) as follows:

If you look on p. 147 for (4264x4265) you will find that Ommie tried and failed to discover the parents of Henry Scott (2132). The genealogy from Adam to Mr. and Mrs. King cites Scot's of Scott's Hall by Anna Siggins White, K.C., 1920, as the authority for Henry Scott being the son of Sir William and Lady Mary (Howard) Scott.

There are three more pages after the one showing the descent from Adam to Israel. One page shows other ancestors of Henry Scott. The other two show lines of descent from various 'Magna Charta Sureties' down to Henry Scott [No. 12]. You can take it from there. Have Fun.

Remarks: There is no record of the birth of Amyes Colle, nor any other children of William Colle except Elizabeth and Empes Cole (see Detail Sheet 4098 x 4099) in the St Andrews Parish Registers. We believe that William was not originally a St Andrews man, and that his children, other than Elizabeth and Empes who were baptized at St Andrews, were born elsewhere.

Amyes Colle (2049) was the daughter of William Colle (4098). That is evidenced by a marriage settlement William Colle (4098) made with his son in law, David Thomson (2048) 1 April 1615, reported in Noyes, p 680

It is only a speculative assumption that Thomas Cole (8196) and his wife Mary (8197) might have been the parents of William Colle (4098). We did not find any evidence that they were.

Woodbury, as a surname, with its variants Woodberry, Woodborough and Woodburgh, is of locality origin, meaning "of Woodbury", a parish of Devonshire, England, or of Woodborough, a parish in Nottinghamshire. In 1216 William de Wodebere held a knight fee at Plymtree. The name occurs in Domesday Book (A. D. 1086) spelled Wodbere. Other early records were in 1273; of David de Wodebir of Devonshire, Edmund de Wodeburg of County Suffolk, Henry and Ralph de Wodeburg of Nottinghamshire. (W. R. Cutter: "Genealogical History of Massachusetts", p 245. C. W. Bardsley: "Dictionary of English and Welsh Surnames.")

William Woodbury (2142), earliest known ancestor of this line in America, was born about 1588, in England, and died in Beverly, Massachusetts, January 29, 1676-77. He is said to have come to America in 1628 and built a house, in 1630, at Mackerel Cove in what is now Beverly. He was made a freeman in Beverly, June 2, 1641.

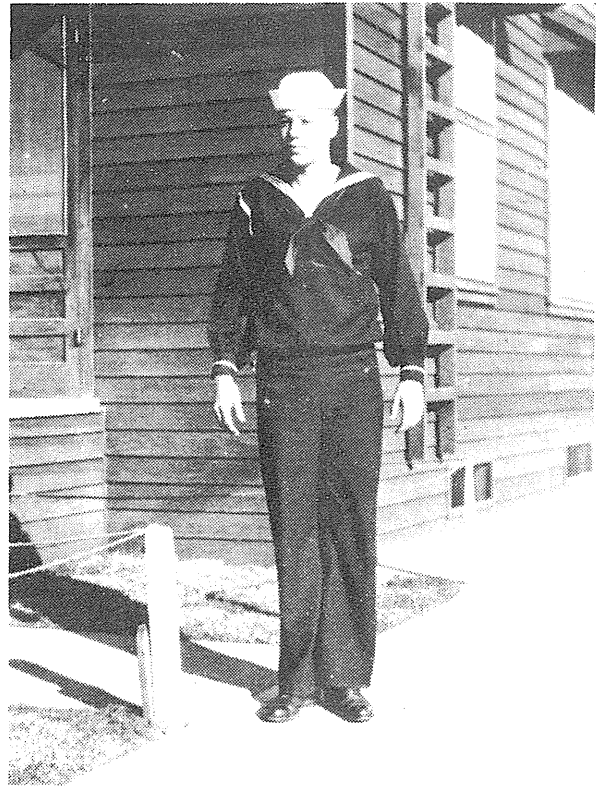

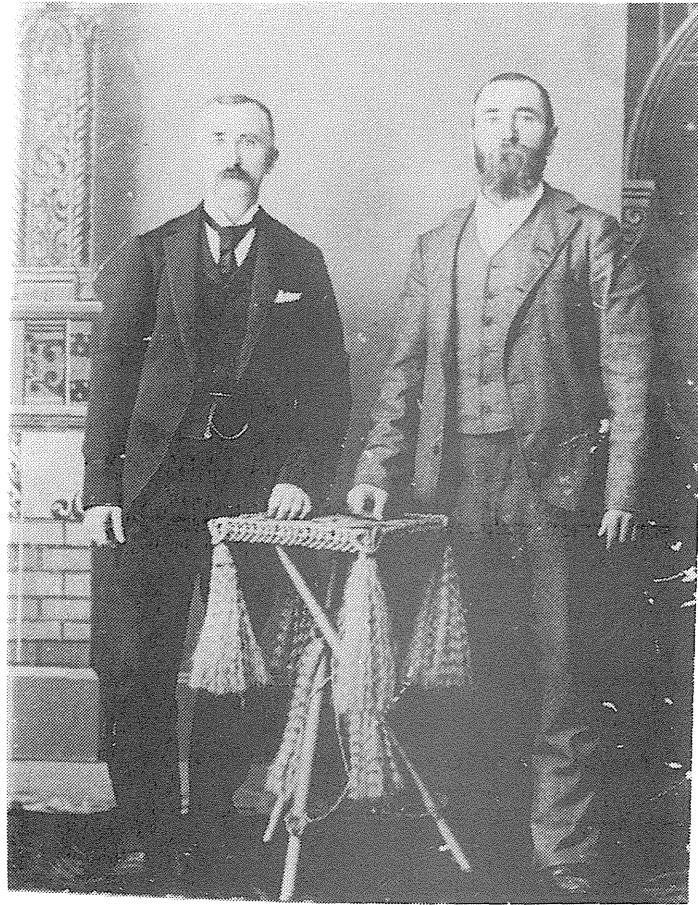
